



## Technical Support Note.

### Installation: 64bit Linux LSB and Operating System

The 64-bit release of Fledermaus is generally compatible with Linux Standard Base (LSB) 3.0 and up systems. Check the Linux Foundation website[1] for more details. See below for a short list of distributions that Fledermaus should be able to run on.

The 64-bit version of Fledermaus is compiled on an LSB 3.1 compliant system. The Linux Foundation asserts that all versions of the LSB beginning with version 3.0 are backwards compatible[2].

Fledermaus has also been tested on a Fedora Core 5 system (which is not certified), where it runs without modification.

Fledermaus for 64-bit Linux should install and run on the following systems using AMD64 or EM64T compatible processors:

Debian 4.0\*  
Fedora Core 5  
RedHat Enterprise Linux 5  
SuSE Linux Enterprise 10  
Ubuntu 6.06\*

Other systems may work also.
